

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
Typing

Topic OI Typing

Typing is a foundational skill when it comes to learning how to use a computer. It's a technical skill that many senior adults may not be familiar with, often requiring motor skills they haven't had much experience with before diving into the world of computers.

At The Playground, we recognize the unique challenges senior adults may face and aim to provide ample opportunities for them to become comfortable with typing. We firmly believe that practice makes perfect, and through sustained practice, senior adults can gradually familiarize themselves with the keyboard layout.

Therefore, in this topic, we place a special emphasis on helping senior adults become acquainted with the keyboard layout, adopting good typing practices, and understanding the utility of various keyboard shortcuts.





PRACTICE

Purpose

To allow senior adults to practice typing on the keyboard and familiarise with the keyboard layout.

When to Practice?

Anytime after learning how to type on a keyboard! We believe that it takes time and practice to famliarise with the keyboard. Practice makes perfect, so one can practice anytime after he has learnt how to use it.



We adopt a bottom-up approach.

Practice basic words and symbols before challenging sentences.

Types of Practices

01 Words

02 Symbols

03 Sentences (A mixture of words and symbols)





How well did I do?

For each practice, we provide an accuracy score that allows participants to track their accuracy of typing.

Number of keys correctly typed / Number of keys wrongly typed

Topic 03 Email





Phishing messages may try to scare you into doing something quickly by saying things like 'Your account will be locked' or 'Immediate action required'.






